

**BRUNSWICK HILLS TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES  
SPECIAL MEETING  
August 6, 2018**

The Brunswick Hills Township Board of Trustees met in special session on Monday, August 6, 2018 at Brunswick Hills Township Town Hall for the purpose of a Public Hearing on the matter of forming a waste disposal district.

Board of Trustees, Chair Michael Esber, Vice-Chair John Witthuhn, Trustee Christina Kusnerak, Zoning Inspector Evelyn Czyz, Elizabeth Biggins-Remer from the Medina County Solid Waste District and twelve members of the public.

Esber called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and noted the meeting was properly advertised.

Biggins-Remer explained that other townships have solid waste districts that help by keeping multiple trucks off the road, providing better prices as well as better services to the residents and other benefits. Biggins-Remer explained the legal requirements and procedures, and gave an example of Montville Township's solid waste district, including bid prices and options.
