

The Board of Trustees of Brunswick Hills Township, Ohio, met in regular session on January 27, 2026, commencing at 7:00 p.m., at the Brunswick Hills Township Town Hall, 1918 Pearl Road, Brunswick Hills, Ohio 44212, with the following members present:

The Fiscal Officer advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

Trustee DeCastra moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 20-2026

A RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING A RENEWAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, OTHER EQUIPMENT, BUILDINGS, AND SITES FOR SUCH BUILDINGS USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT OR PART-TIME POLICE, COMMUNICATIONS, OR ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF ANY EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS REQUIRED FOR SUCH PERSONNEL UNDER SECTION 145.48 OR 742.33 OF THE REVISED CODE, OR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS INCURRED BY TOWNSHIPS AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTS MADE WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN POLICE PROTECTION, OR THE PROVISION OF AMBULANCE OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A POLICE DEPARTMENT IN BRUNSWICK HILLS TOWNSHIP, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.19(J), 5705.191, 5705.25 AND 5705.26 OF THE REVISED CODE, TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT AT THE ELECTION ON MAY 5, 2026.

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2026 this Board adopted Resolution No. 19-2026 declaring it necessary to renew a two and five-tenths (2.5) mill levy tax for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of the costs incurred by townships as a

result of contracts made with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection, or the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department, in Brunswick Hills Township, Medina County, Ohio, pursuant to Section 5705.19(J) and/or 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code, and requesting the Medina County Auditor to certify to this Board the rates and amounts specified in Section 5705.03(B)(2) of the Revised Code that would be generated by that renewed levy.

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2026, the Medina County Auditor certified that the property tax revenue that will be produced by that (2.5) mill renewal levy, assuming the taxable value of Brunswick Hills Township remains constant throughout the life of the levy is calculated to be \$845,000 per year during the life of the levy; the total taxable value of the Brunswick Hills Township used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$525,101,220 and that the millage of the requested levy is (2.5) mills per \$1.00 of taxable value, which amounts to \$56.00 for each \$100,000 of County Auditor's market value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Brunswick Hills Township, Medina County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1. This Board finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised by the Township, within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to meet the needs of Brunswick Hills Township and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of the costs incurred by townships as a result of contracts made with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection, or the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department, in Brunswick Hills Township, Medina County, Ohio, and any and all purposes now or hereafter allowed under Section 5705.19(J) of the Revised Code at a rate not exceeding two and five-tenths (2.5) mills for each one-dollar (\$1.00) of taxable value, for (5) years and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of (2.5) mills, to be levied upon the entire territory of Brunswick Hills Township, with 2026 the tax year in which the tax will first be levied and 2027 the calendar year in which the tax will first be collected, and the question of this renewal levy shall be submitted to the electors of said Brunswick Hills Township within the entire territory of Brunswick Hills Township at the election to be held at the usual voting places within said Brunswick Hills Township on the 5th day of May, 2026; as authorized by Sections, 5705.19(J), 5705.191, 5705.25 and 5705.26 of the Revised Code, Medina County being the only county in which Brunswick Hills Township has territory.

Section 2. That said tax shall first be levied in 2026 and first be collected in 2027, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. The Township Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to deliver (i) a certified copy of Resolution No. 19-2026 referred to in the first preamble of this resolution, (ii) the certificate of the Medina County Auditor referred to in the second preamble of this resolution, and (iii) a certified copy of this Resolution, to the Medina County Board of Elections and the Medina County Auditor no later than 90 days before the election on May 5, 2026.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board or committees, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.

Trustee Nixon seconded the motion.


