RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NECESSITY TO CLOSE PLUM CREEK PARKWAY FOR
THE PURPOSE OF CULVERT REPLACEMENT
BRUNSWICK HILLS TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Brunswick Hills Township met in regular session on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, commencing at 7:00 PM.

WHEREAS, per section 5571.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Brunswick Hills Township Board of Trustees has determined it necessary to close Plum Creek Parkway between 2308 and 2417 in order to complete necessary culvert replacement.

WHEREAS, the Brunswick Hills Township Service Department will be repairing a road culvert;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Brunswick Hills Township, Medina County, Ohio, will resolve to close Plum Creek Parkway on July 6, 2026, for 4 days, for repairs to a culvert located between 2308 and 2417. Plum Creek Parkway will reopen on July 10, 2026.
